ORGANISATION

The RTO was established in response to a recognised need for manufacturers to undertake lean manufacturing processes. It was established by two lean manufacturing consultants out of Toyota in Europe.

The RTO worked primarily with enterprise clients with an interest in using the programs (accredited and nonaccredited) to improve the efficiency of their operations. The RTO delivered consultancy and training services to large and small enterprises across a range of industry sectors, with a particular focus on the automotive supply chain. Its corporate clients for consultancy services were spread across Australia, Europe, North America and the United Kingdom. Accredited programs were delivered solely in Australia.

The training and assessment staff were all lean manufacturing experts with first hand experience of working at Toyota, the original designer of lean manufacturing processes.

All training was workplace based to ensure that training linked with improvement processes in these organisations and that the learning process was authentic in its content and support for learning. Programs were generally enterprise funded as well as some traineeships.

The RTO has a relationship with the University of Ballarat to provide that institution with expert trainers and assessors. Currently the RTO delivered training to around 650 students across Australia. This training is generally funded by the client enterprise, but there are some traineeships funded in Queensland and Victoria.
